### SINCE THE DRAFT



Adam Burnett has began his second Ontario Junior Hockey League (OJHL) season with the Burlington Cougars.

The Waterdown, ON native was the Petes' 6th round, 106th overall pick in the 2012 Ontario Hockey League Priority Selection. Prior to being selected by the Petes, Adam competed for the Minor Midget AAA Hamilton Jr. Bulldogs in the Alliance League, where he tallied 4 goals and 11 assists for 15 points in 50 games.

In his first season of junior hockey, with the Burlington Cougars, he tallied 2 goals and 6 assists for 8 points in 44 games.

Adam competed in both the Petes Development Camp (May 2013) and the Petes Training Camp (August 2013). He was reassigned back to the Burlington Cougars at the end of the training camp.

In 7 games played this season with the Burlington Cougars, Adam has recorded 2 assists.

Look for Adam to have a breakout season with the Cougars, and possibly suit-up for the Maroon and White in the near future.

### SINCE THE PETES

Professional hockey journeyman, Jamie Tardif is set to begin the current season with the Rochester Americans of the American Hockey League.

The Welland, ON native will be competing in his 12th season of professional hockey, which began with the Toledo Storm of the East Coast Hockey League (ECHL) during the 2006-07 season.

Prior to his professional career, Jamie laced up the skates in 324 regular season games for the Maroon and White, where he tallied a total of 155 goals, 136 assists for a total of 291 points. His OHL career culminated in a J. Ross Robertson championship season, after leading the Petes past the highly talented London Knights in 4 straight games.

Jamie has spent most of his professional hockey career in the American Hockey League, playing for: Manitoba; Iowa; Grand Rapids and Providence. He has also competed in the 2013 AHL All Star game representing the hometown Providence Bruins.

Jamie has also competed in 2 games with the NHL's Boston Bruins during the 2012-13 season. The Petes wish Jamie the best in his future hockey endeavours.

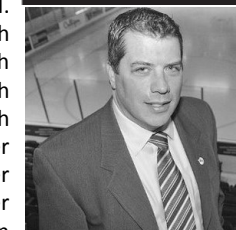
