**PARKING:**

Parking garage access at the Martin Conference Center at Harvard Medical School is a \$25 flat fee and must be reserved in advance; contact Melissa Lin at [melin@edc.org](mailto:melin@edc.org) to reserve a space.

**LOCAL TRANSPORTATION:**

**Taxi Service:** The recommended hotels and Conference Center are located approximately 6-7 miles from the airport (a 20 minute ride), and the estimated taxi fare is \$25 - \$35. There are 24-hour cab stands in front of every airport terminal. From your hotel, feel free to ask the concierge or front desk to help order a cab. Below are some of the local taxi companies.

**Public Transit From Logan Airport:** Board the free Massport shuttle buses (Routes Nos. 22, 33, or 55 to “MBTA Blue Line”) outside your terminal. The Massport shuttle buses, which have extra storage space for luggage, will drop you off directly in front of Airport Station where you can purchase your CharlieTicket at the ticket machines inside the station’s lobby. Insert your CharlieTicket in the turnstyle to access the station platform. Take the Blue Line in the direction of Bowdoin. Exit the Blue Line at Government Center (4th stop). Change to the Green Line (E Line - Heath Street only; do NOT get on B, C, or D trains). Exit at the **Longwood Medical Area stop**. Cross Huntington Ave to Longwood Ave on foot. Walk 1 block to Avenue Louis Pasteur (Conference Center).

**Some options for getting around town –**

**Traveling on the MBTA:** The MBTA offers train and bus services throughout the Longwood Area. The best travel options are listed below. Please [visit the mbta.com](http://www.mbta.com) to plan your own route and for information on travel fares. The MBTA also offers [mobile apps](#) and a [service alerts notification system](#) for real-time service updates and transit information.

**Via Subway:**

- **Green Line D train**
  - *From the Conference Center heading Inbound (downtown):* Facing the Longwood Galleria, take a right onto Longwood Ave, turn left onto Staircase to Riverway Path, take the stairs, and arrive at the **Longwood station** (about a 13 minute walk). Train makes stops at Fenway, Kenmore, Copley, and Government Center stations.
  - *From downtown heading Outbound (back to Conference Center):* Take the D train to Longwood station. From station, turn left onto Chapel Street and walk up short hill to Longwood Ave. Turn left onto Longwood Ave.
- **Green Line E train**
  - *From the Conference Center heading Inbound (downtown):* Facing the Longwood Galleria, take a left onto Longwood Ave, turn left onto Huntington Ave, and the **Longwood Medical Area**

**station** will be on your right (about a 5 minute walk). Train makes stops at Museum of Fine Arts, Northeastern University, Symphony, Prudential, Copley, and Lechmere stations.

- *From downtown heading Outbound (back to Conference Center):* Take the E train to Longwood Medical Area station. From here, proceed down Longwood Avenue towards the hospitals. Arrive at the Conference Center on Avenue Louis Pasteur on your right.
