On December 6th, the Chairperson of the team delivered the report to the faculty and administration. The team concurred and recommended that Msgr. Scanlan HS is deserving of re-accreditation. Official word is expected in early spring.

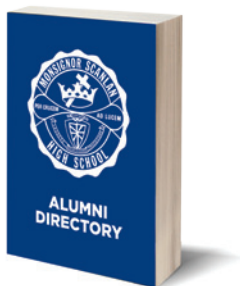
