CANDIDATE GUIDELINES FOR THE CARI SCHOLARSHIP

The CARI Board has chosen to establish and fund one or more yearly scholarships for the benefit of CARI affiliate members. This educational scholarship has been created to give our dedicated members and/or their dependant's economic opportunities to attend college or further their career training. The application open enrollment period shall be designated February 15th to May 31st.

The dollar amount and number of scholarships awarded each year shall be predetermined by a majority vote of the CARI Board in the last board meeting of the year preceding the yearly scholarship open enrollment period.

The CARI Board has unanimously agreed to provide THREE \$500 SCHOLARSHIPS for the first year of funding; thereby being awarded in October 2014.

Eligibility requirements & documentation requirements:

1. Applicant must be a full paying dues member for at least 3 years OR

Be a dependent child (of a full paying dues member of at least 3 years) under the age of 26 OR

Be a legal spouse or certified partner of an eligible member living in the same household.

Note: Nonmember fee payers and retirees or their families are not eligible.

2. Provide proof of legal permanent residence (i.e. birth certificate, CA driver's license, or ID).

3. Provide a copy of High School Diploma or GED.

4. Proof of enrollment in a college or trade school (i.e. most recent transcript or contract)

OR

A High School Transcript showing a grade point average of at least 3.0 or higher.

5. A passport style, picture of yourself.

6. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, professor, school counselor or employer.

7. A one page essay (introduction of self and career goals)

Applicant must submit the completed CARI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM with the requested documents to: CARI BOARD, 2029 "H" St., Sacramento, CA 95811, postmarked no later than May 31st for scholarships to be awarded in the current scholarship year.

NOTE: In the event applicant does not enter a college, university, or trade school by Aug 15th of the year following award of the scholarship, then he or she must reimburse the awarded scholarship amount to the CARI board and may re-apply for a new scholarship.

These scholarships will be available through an application process and review by the CARI Board. The Board will evaluate each application submitted during the application period and determine by way of a majority vote, the scholarship(s) recipient.
