SUBMISSION ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All submissions **MUST** be submitted electronically.

- > Multiple projects may be submitted but will need to be saved in separate subfolders within your DropBox folder.
- Each folder should be named: Submission 1, Submission 2 & so on.

When complete, you will have two sets of information for every submission:

- (1) With Design Category Page and Concept Statement, all photos, drawings, plans and (optional) pictures of materials used but no identification of any kind; and
- (2) A separate Concealed Identification folder with all completed forms and identification therein.

The submissions should be made in the following order:

Page #1 -Design Category page:

- This page must be filled out completely.
- Please clearly mark the Design Specialty Category & complete the Design Project Checklist.

Page #2 - Concept Statement:

- Please specify the category in which you are entering on top left corner of this page
- Save this statement AND the Design Category page together, for the Judges to use.

NO names or addresses of the project, client or design firm may appear in this statement.

Page #3- Project Submittal

- All photographs submitted must be taken by a professional photographer and at least 300 dpi.
- A minimum of TWO interior photographs are required.
 - o They MUST be full color AND 8X10 prints (when printed)
 - EXCEPT for SINGLE SPACE or DESIGNER HOUSE one print is the necessary amount for those
- A floor plan(s), reduced but legible is required.
 - o MUST fit when printed on 8 ½" x 11" or 11" x 17" (folded)
- Elevations, details, color or fabric swatches are encouraged but not required

PLEASE save all photographs, elevations, floor plans, and details into your folder labeled Submission 1 (or the correct number of your Submission) WITH the Design Category page AND Concept Statement page.

NO names or addresses of the project, client or design firm may appear in the photographs or the printed material.



SUBMISSION ENTRY REQUIREMENTS [cont'd]

Concealed Identification Packet:

- To ensure confidentiality, the following items must be concealed.
 - 1. Please save a "Concealed Identification Packet" in EACH submission DropBox subfolder, which should each be labeled "Submission 1", "Submission 2", etc.
- FORMS to include in EACH folder:
 - 1. Concealed Identification Form
 - 2. Consultants Identification Form
 - 3. Owner Permission Form
 - 4. Photography Permission Form.

Once received, you will receive a confirmation email which certifies your items have been uploaded to DropBox and entered into the Award Database.

ELIGIBILITY

Participants **MUST** be:

- 1. ASID Carolinas members in good standing
- 2. Actively engaged in the practice of interior design.

Awards will be presented to **individuals**, not firms.

ENTRIES

- Each entry, except for the Designer House category must represent a permanent installation completed no earlier than January 1, 2011 (three years prior to "award year").
- Designer House category each entry must represent an installation completed no earlier than January 1, 2013 (one year prior to the "award year").
- There shall be a limit of two (2) entries per category.
- Each entry requires an entry fee.
- A project submitted by a Designer with fellow team members will require the team member's
 names and certification by the Firm's principal that the Designer was responsible for 51% or greater
 participation in the submitted design project.
- Projects featured in print media may be entered.
- Non-winning projects may be re-entered in the following year providing the entry meets the calendar year requirements.
- With the exception of Specialty Category entries, photo submission shall not be "staged vignettes"
- Each entry photo shall represent a submission comprising an entire room.

Entries not following instructions or not meeting the criteria and eligibility rules will be disqualified.



SUBMISSION ENTRY REQUIREMENTS [cont'd]

AWARDS

- There are 3 possible Awards:
 - 1. A First Place Excellence In Design Award
 - 2. A Second Place Excellence In Design Award and
 - 3. An Honorable Mention Excellence In Design Award
- The Honorable Mention Excellence In Design Award is given to a project that exemplifies excellence
 in meeting the judges' criteria, but not at the same level of achievement as the First and Second
 Place Excellence In Design Awards.
- No awards will be given in categories where the entries have not produced an outstanding project
- Each project is judged against the design criteria, not each other.
- Winners will be honored at the Excellence in Design Awards Gala, published in Carolinas Eye on Design, winter issue, and featured on the ASID Carolinas web site.

CONCEPT

The design competition recognizes projects by members of the ASID Carolinas that represent excellence in interior design by successfully addressing client objectives and demonstrating creativity and skillful problem solving in the following design criteria categories.

DESIGN CRITERIA

- Success in meeting the client needs (aesthetic & functional) as stated in Concept.
- Creative response to client's stated needs/objectives
- Use of space planning to achieve functional objectives
- Scale and proportion
- Color Composition
- Effective use of light
- The relationship of the materials, and their textures and patterns
- Effective use of budget
- Attention to detail

JUDGES

- Professional ASID members of another chapter will judge the projects.
 - o All decisions made by the judges are final.
 - o The judges reserve the right not to issue an award for any category where they do not feel the quality of the work meets certain design standards.
 - They also reserve the right to award any combination of honors in a particular category e.g. a Second Place Award in absence of a First Place Award.
