

BCYC Junior Sailing Program

Summer Sailing
June 24 – August 2, 2013

Starfish Program *** Ages 5 - 7***

Eligibility: The Starfish class is offered to children 5 to 7 years of age. This is an introductory class which provides children with knowledge on sailing, knot tying, safety, and water-related activities. Weekly activities include: sailing a variety of different boats, swim lessons with our certified swimming instructor, and much more.

Requirements: Sailors must have a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use.

Hours: Classes are held Monday - Friday from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm.

Sabot- Novice Beginning Sailing Program ***Ages 7-11***

Eligibility: The Novice class is an all-embracing, fun-filled class for children 7-11 years of age. This class is designed for first time sailors, and covers the introduction of the Naples Sabot, Boat Parts, Knots, and On the Water Sailing. The focus of this class is to teach kids how to learn, love and operate their Sabot. **Requirements:** Sailors must be able to

complete and pass a swimming test, have a Naples Sabot and a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use.

Hours: Classes are held Monday - Friday from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm.

Sabot- Advanced Novice Sailing Program***Ages 8-11***

Eligibility: The Novice Advanced class is designed for sailors who have successfully completed a full summer of Novice sailing at BCYC or equivalent but not yet ready for the C3 racing.

Requirements: Sailors must be able to complete and pass a swimming test, have a Naples Sabot and a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use.

Hours: Classes are held Monday - Friday from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm.

Sabot C Racing Program ***Ages 8-16***

Eligibility: The Sabot C2 & C3 Program is available to children between 8-16 years of age. Sailors will be divided into classes according to their ability. This will be a skill-building class, as we will teach the kids how to maneuver their boat in basic race-course situations. Sailors who reach the C1 level by the end of the summer are strongly encouraged to compete in the 2013 Sabot National Championship hosted by Mission Bay Yacht Club, August $5^{th} - 8^{h}$.

Requirements: Sailors must be able to complete and pass a swimming test, have a Naples Sabot and a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use. Parents are required to pull a trailer to travel regattas.

Hours: Classes are held Monday - Friday from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm.

Sabot- Nationals Program (A, B & C1) ***Ages 9-17***

Eligibility: The Sabot A, B, & C1 Nationals Program is available to children between 9-17 years of age. This program is open to Sabot A B, & C1 sailors working towards a strong finish at Sabot Nationals. Advanced boat handling, racing tactics and rules will be covered extensively. The 2013 Sabot National Championship will be hosted by Mission Bay Yacht Club, August $5^{th} - 8^{th}$.

Requirements: Sailors must be able to complete and pass a swimming test, have a Naples Sabot and a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use. Parents are required to pull a trailer to travel regattas.

Hours: Classes are held Monday - Friday from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm.

<u>CFJ Program</u> ***Ages 13-18***

Eligibility: The CFJ Program is available to children between 13-18 years of age. The racer must possess a desire to participate in all practices, suggested regattas and the reading of the development materials, with the goal to improve their racing skills both on and off the water. Participants are strongly encouraged to participate in both the Junior Olympic Festival July 12-14 at Newport Harbor Yacht Club and the 2013 CFJ Nationals.

Requirements: Sailors must be able to complete and pass a swimming test, have 3 or

more years of racing experience, have access to a CFJ (a limited number of CFJ's will be available for charter) and a United States Coast Guard (U.S.C.G.) approved life jacket for their use. Parents are required to pull a trailer to travel regattas.

Hours: Classes are held Monday – Friday from 12:30 pm to 5:00 pm.

At this time, parent manuals, class schedules, parent of the day and committee assignments will be distributed.
