1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 USCG -approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 Sabot A fleet boats may be subject to on-the-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to the International Naples Sabot Association (INSA) class rules for a list of required equipment.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all "Junior" CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Sabot A, B, C1, C2, and C3 from Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association (SCYYRA) clubs.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online at <u>www.bcyc.org</u> before 5pm on May 17, 2013.
- 2.3 The Entry Fee for all Classes is \$20.00

3. SCHEDULE

3.1 Mandatory check-in will be on Saturday, May 18, 2013 from 9:30am until 10:30am in the Banquet Room at BCYC.

5. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

- 5.1 Race Venue 1: CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Sabot A, B and C1 boats will sail in the Newport Harbor Turning Basin.
- 5.2 Race Venue 2: Sabot C3 and C2 boats will sail in the vicinity of Lido Isle Yacht Club.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta
- 6.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores.

6.3 When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.
