1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 Sabot A fleet boats may be subject to on-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to INSA class rules for a list of required equipment.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all junior age Laser, Laser Radial, CFJ, Sabot A, B, C1, C2, C3 sailors.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online at www.regattanetwork.com on or before 10/22/13 at 11:59pm PDT to receive the early entry discount. ***Advanced registration is greatly appreciated.***

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online & upon check-in at BCYC.

5. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

- 5.1 Race Venue 1: CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Sabot A, B and C1 boats will sail in the Turning Basin.
- 5.2 Race Venue 2: Sabot C3 and C2 boat will sail in the vicinity of the M Mark.
- 5.3 Courses may be a windward – leeward or any variation of a triangle or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 6.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores. This changes RRS A2.
- 6.3 The Corinthian Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the yacht club with the best overall combined score (high point) for all classes and races.
