These beanies and blankets are delivered free of charge to patients across the country. We hope for a day when our services will no longer be needed, but until then our recipients continually tell us that our beanies not only provide warmth as they go through treatment but also provide them an incredible amount of dignity during the most challenging time of their lives.

We currently donate over 4,000 caps and Neonatal Intensive Care blankets per month to over 500 cancer centers and NICU in the US. The need is great. Since our inception, we've donated over 194,000 caps and over 2,000 NICU blankets. All given away free of charge.
