◆ CHARGES FROM FATAL WRECK

A Cartersville man turned himself into the Bartow County Jail on charges related to an April 16, 2013, wreck that killed Alfred Dobbins, 45, Kingston. The Georgia State Patrol said Dobbins was traveling south on Highway 293 on his motorcycle when a north-bound Toyota pickup truck made a left turn into his path. The motorcycle hit the passenger side of the pickup truck. The driver of the pickup truck Cang Phuc Ly, 35, Stiles Fairway, Cartersville, is charged with homicide by vehicle and failure to yield the right of way.

♦ MAN STABBED DURING FIGHT

A 52 year old man received a severe cut to his stomach during a domestic dispute Saturday morning. Bartow County Sheriff Clark Millsap said deputies responded to 4522 Scenic Mountain Road, Acworth, around 8:00 a.m. and found Charles Smith, 52, stabbed. The investigation revealed Smith and Jody Crumpton, Jr., 22, had been involved in a physical fight when Crumpton stabbed Smith outside the residence. Crumpton had been staying at the house prior to the fight. Smith was transported to Grady Hospital in Atlanta for treatment. Crumpton is in the Bartow County Jail charged with aggravated assault under the family violence act.

- ♦ Around 3:30 a.m. Friday a man riding a bicycle was killed. Cartersville Police were called to Highway 41 and Zena Drive. Floyd Hardin, 54, was riding a bicycle with no lights and was struck by a Jeep Cherokee driven by Derrick Hardin, 22. Floyd Hardin died from his injuries. The driver of the Jeep, Derrick Hardin, told police "I had like 4 to 5 beers a few hours ago." Hardin is charged with D.U.I. alcohol and violating his D.U.I. driving permit.
- ♦ A man trying to outrun Bartow County Sheriff's Deputies is in jail. A deputy saw a Toyota 4-Runner weaving. When deputies tried to stop the vehicle it accelerated and continued to drive on Jones Mill Rd. The vehicle drove on the wrong side of the road and failed to stop at a stop sign.
