### LOCAL NEWS

#### ◆ LUNAR ECLIPSE THIS MORNING

Early this morning the red moon total lunar eclipse is expected to be visible over Northwest Georgia. The Tellus Science Museum will open their doors at 5:00 a.m. for guests to view the total lunar eclipse. The next total lunar eclipse will be September, 2015.

#### ◆ TAILGATE DOWNTOWN

The Cartersville Downtown Development Authority will have the rescheduled October "Second" Friday event on Friday, October 10th at Friendship Plaza in historic downtown Cartersville. The event named "College Tailgate" will start at 5 p.m. with kid's activities, food by Mellow Mushroom, music with Tom & Chad and a corn hole tournament. There is a \$25 registration fee to be part of this tournament. You can register for the tournament at the Cartersville Welcome Center or register the day of the event. There's only space for the first 15 teams. Those attending are urged to sport your favorite college football team attire.

#### ◆ CAR SCRAPED WITHOUT PERMISSION

A woman said she left her Ford Escort with a friend on Old Farm Road near the beginning of September because it needed repairs. She went to the residence and found it was gone. Lagina Manley told Bartow County Sheriff's Deputies that she started calling scrap yards and found her car had been crushed. The name of the person who scraped the car was given to deputies by the business that scraped the car.

### TOP NEWS

◆ An EF-1 tornado swept through Ringgold Monday night damaging at least 7 homes in a neighborhood. The National Weather Service said wind speeds reached 110 m.p.h. No injuries were reported.

◆ The leaves in the Great Smoky Mountains are starting to put on their display of fall colors. Officials say the best color is still a week or so away. From early to mid October fall colors develop above 4,000 feet. The park service suggests driving the Clingmans Dome Rd., The Blue Ridge Parkway or the Foothills Parkway.

◆ U.S. military officials in Japan said the body of Senior Master Sgt. James Swartz who was stationed in Georgia has been recovered. The missing airmen were identified as Master Sgt. Daniel Paschal and Sgt. Joshua Schoenhoff. They were on temporary duty at Kedena Air Base when typhoon waves carried them out to sea.

◆ Madrid's regional government said it's going to euthanize the pet dog of a Spanish woman who became infected with Ebola. The nursing assistant became the first case of Ebola being transmitted outside of West Africa after she cared for a Spanish priest who died of Ebola. The woman and her husband are now in quarantine.
