### LOCAL NEWS

#### ◆ UNKNOWN ASSAILANT SHOOTS MAN

Bartow Co. Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to 5119 Kings Camp Rd., Saturday morning to a gun shot wound. Matthew Olsen told officers someone wearing a mask came into his bedroom and shot him in the leg. Olsen was taken by ambulance to an area hospital.

#### ◆ BORROWED CAR NOT RETURNED

A 26 year old Adairsville man was arrested Saturday after his soon to be ex-mother in law reported her car stolen. She told Bartow Sheriff's Deputies she let John Alton Cox, III, borrow her vehicle and told him to bring the car back but he refused. Cox is charged with fleeing and attempting to elude an officer, driving while license withdrawn and passing in a no passing zone.

#### ◆ WHAT'S NEXT?

A Bartow Co. Superior Court jury found Michael Ray West not guilty on one count of obstruction of a law enforcement officer and no verdict on two counts of obstruction of a law enforcement officer. He was found not guilty of three counts of attempted removal of a weapon from a public officer. The District Attorney's office said West made bond after his arrest and should remain out on bond unless he violates the conditions of his bond until his criminal case is completed. Officers raided a business West owned in Emerson in 2013. His family claimed excessive force after an officer stepped on his head and he was injured during the arrest at his business.

### TOP NEWS

◆ Federal investigators charged Williams Scott Associates LLC of Norcross, its owner John Todd Williams and six of its employees who contacted consumers whose debt WSA had purchased and tried to trick and coerce them into making payments. One of the six arrested was Christopher Lenyszyn, 46, Acworth. Manhattan U.S. Attorney Preet Bharara said "as alleged, the defendants third party debt collectors acting under the guise of government authority illegally and repeatedly threatened arrest, prosecution and prison for countless Americans."

◆ A grand jury in Ferguson, Missouri, will reconvene today to consider on whether to indict the police officer who shot and killed teenager Michael Brown. Several protesters were arrested over the weekend.

◆ Longtime mayor of Washington, D.C., Marion Barry, 78, has died. Barry had been battling kidney problems stemming from diabetes.

◆ At least 45 people died after a suicide bomber blew himself up at a volleyball tournament in eastern Afghanistan Sunday. The attack came after Parliament approved agreements allowing U.S. and NATO troops to stay in the country past the end of the year.
