Dr. Garth Rosell is Professor of Church History at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, where he has taught for nearly thirty years. For ten of those years, he has also served as Dean and Vice President of Academic Affairs. Dr. Rosell's first love is the classroom, where he teaches hundreds of students each year. He possesses a profound understanding of theological and historical roots of spiritual awakenings. He defines an Awakening as:

*"A renewal of spiritual vitality sent to the church by God's Spirit and always producing in the life of the believer a deeper love for God and a more active concern for one's neighbor."*



Dr. Edward Eastman is the Senior Pastor of Greenwood's Community Church in Ashley Falls, Massachusetts and a part-time professor of spiritual formation at Rockbridge Seminary. Dr. Eastman is a graduate of Cairn University (formerly Philadelphia Biblical University), Dallas Theological Seminary, and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary where he earned his Doctor of Ministry degree in Revival and Reform under Dr. Rosell.

Dr. Eastman has written several articles on the spiritual heritage of our region, especially that of Connecticut's Upper Housatonic River Valley, and has led several regional *Rediscovering Our Spiritual Heritage Tours*. His passion is to see churches of our region experience spiritual renewal and awakening in our generation.
