Dr. Garth Rosell is Professor of Church History at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, where he has taught for nearly thirty years. For ten of those years, he has also served as Dean and Vice President of Academic Affairs. He possesses a profound understanding of theological and historical roots of spiritual awakenings.

Dr. Edward Eastman is the Senior Pastor of Greenwoods Community Church in Ashley Falls, Massachusetts and a part-time professor of spiritual formation at Rockbridge Seminary. Dr. Eastman is a graduate of Cairn University (formerly Philadelphia Biblical University), Dallas Theological Seminary, and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary where he earned his Doctor of Ministry degree in Revival and Reform under Dr. Rosell

Driving Directions to Collinsville Congregational Church:
From Rte. 44 (Heading West from Hartford, Simsbury):
Proceed through intersection of Rte. 44 & Rte. 177 in Canton. At next light take left onto Dowd Avenue towards Collinsville. Continue into Collinsville until river is on your right. At cannon, (on your left) take a left onto River Street. Continue across Main Street. Church is directly ahead.

From Rte. 44 (Heading from Winsted):
At stop light of intersection Rte. 44 & Rte. 179, take right onto River Road (Rte. 179S). Continue to stop sign, take right onto Bridge Street (Rte. 179S). At cannon, (on your left) take a left onto River Street. Continue across Main Street. Church is directly ahead.

From Rte. 202 (Heading East from Torrington):
At intersection of Rte. 202 & Rte. 179, take right onto River Road (179S). Continue to stop sign. Take right onto Bridge Street (Rte. 179S). At cannon, (on your left) take a left onto River Street. Continue across Main Street. Church is directly ahead.

From Rte. 4 East & West (Farmington, Burlington):
At junction of Rte. 4 & Rte. 179, continue on Rte. 179N, towards Collinsville. Proceed to stop sign (St. Patrick's Church on left), take left onto Bridge Street (Rte. 179N). Take first right onto Main Street, which swings left. Take first right onto Front Street, which swings (turns) left onto South Street. Church will be on your right.
