Materials:

- Small to medium-sized faux/ foam pumpkin
- Non-toxic permanent markers, paint, and/or paint pens (please make sure they are non-toxic)
- Stickers, foam stickers, etc. (if desired)



Decorate a Halloween pumpkin for a child @ Phoenix Children's Hospital

Description:

Decorate a faux/foam pumpkin to be given to a patient at Phoenix Children's Hospital at Halloween.

Instructions:

- Purchase a small to medium-sized faux/foam pumpkin(s) to decorate. The pumpkins can be found at craft stores, discount stores (e.g. Dollar Tree) and other retailers such as Target, etc. Real pumpkins can not be used due to spoilage issues.
- Decorate the pumpkins with markers, paint, paint pens, stickers, foam stickers, etc. (Please make sure they are non-toxic). If words are used, it is very important to avoid language referring to someone's health, such as "get better soon,"" feel better," etc. or any religious connotations.
- Once completed, you can bring the pumpkins to our Halloween event at PCH on Oct. 11th (if registered). You can also drop them off at Phoenix Children's Hospital or any PCH Urgent Care in the Valley (addresses below) anytime before October 29th.
