

Potowomut Golf Club depends on all its members to dress in an appropriate fashion. Members are responsible for informing their guests of the dress code prior to use of the golf course and clubhouse.

# **Dress on the Golf Course and Practice Facilities:**

### Suitable Attire for Men:

- Slacks or shorts of appropriate length, no denim material
- Shirts must have a collar (includes turtleneck and mock turtleneck collars) and are to be worn tucked in

## Suitable Attire for Women:

- Golf skirts, slacks or shorts of appropriate length, no denim material
- Women's golf shirts maybe either collarless or sleeveless

## **Dress in the Clubhouse:**

#### Suitable Attire for Men:

- Slacks or shorts of appropriate length
- Shirts must have a collar (includes turtleneck and mock turtleneck collars) and are to be worn tucked in, camp shirts are permissible
- Jeans that are free from rips, tears etc. are permitted in the Clubhouse during normal operation; Jeans are not permitted for Special Events

### Suitable Attire for Women:

- Golf skirts, slacks or shorts of appropriate length, no denim material
- Women's golf shirts maybe either collarless or sleeveless
- Jeans that are free from rips, tears etc. are permitted in the Clubhouse during normal operation; Jeans are not permitted for Special Events

# Please Note:

For men and women, gym shorts, sweat pants, short shorts, tank tops, "slogan" tee shirts, cut-offs and bathing suits are considered inappropriate. Hats and caps are to be worn properly with the front facing forward not backward or to the side. Members and their guests may walk from the parking lot to the locker room to change from inappropriate attire to appropriate attire prior to using the golf course, practice facilities or the clubhouse.
