## *What is the DCPCS Recycling Program?*

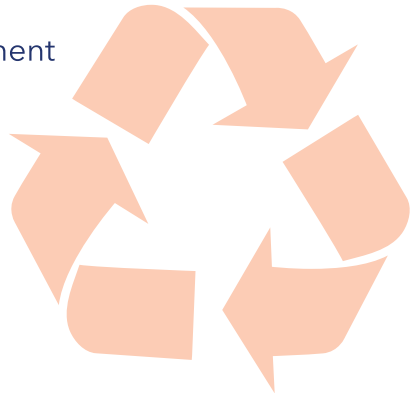

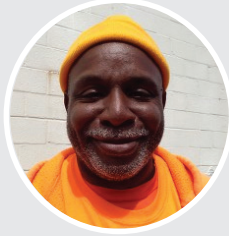
