Sunset Strolls

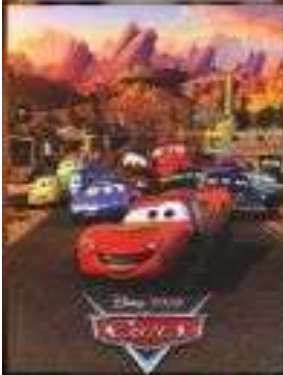
