Description: Enjoy the beauty of Dog Canyon at sundown. Watch the moonrise over the Sacramento escarpment. The Sturgeon Moon takes its name from the Algonquin names for the months. Those tribes that relied on fishing knew that large sturgeons were more easily caught during this month. A Super Moon is when the full moon is at perigee (closest to the earth) in its lunar orbit, although most of us would not notice the difference. Come enjoy stories and myths about the moon.

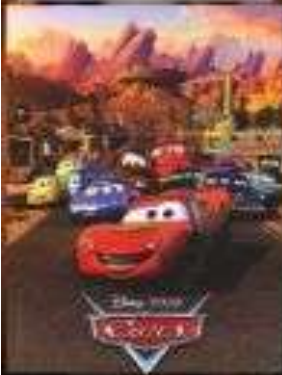
