In the last year, the Enhanced Education of Infection Prevention in Nursing Homes modules 1 and 2 have been viewed over 1250 times by nursing home staff members!

Today, we are launching modules 3 and 4 which focus on injection safety and glucometer care, and environmental disinfection.
