This fund also supports infant CPR kits—every new family at Saint Clare's receives one—the safe sitter program, and the lactation program and the Mommy Café (a support group for new mothers).

Compassionate Care: This important fund helps patients with food, transportation, medication or clothing needs they may have when they leave the hospital.

"After transforming the historic Rothschild Pavilion a year ago into a winter wonderland of excitement, our organizing committee has been working hard to make it bigger and better for participants of all ages," said Olszewski.

Admission to Angels Among Us is free, but some activities will have a nominal fee with all proceeds from the event benefiting the Foundation. "These programs touch so many lives and we hope the entire community will continue to embrace this event to support our patients in need." added Olszewski.
