NOTICE FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that public hearings will be held for the purpose of obtaining public input regarding possible changes to Metro Ride bus routes, paratransit services and passenger fares. Possible changes are as follows:

- Route K – Schofield/Rothschild/Weston may be modified to eliminate a portion of the route that serves the area south of Highway 29, which includes Marshfield Clinic, St. Clare's Hospital and Birchwood Highlands.
- Route K – Schofield/Rothschild/Weston may be eliminated entirely, along with all paratransit service in the City of Schofield, Village of Rothschild and Village of Weston.
- Passenger Fares may be increased as follows:
