Dear Senator Warner;

I urge you to vote no for Senate Bill 1537. This Bill sets a dangerous precedent in which decisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's Medical Review Board are reprosecuted for political purposes.

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration has a difficult task in keeping our roads safe. It must decide which medical conditions are compatible with safe truck operations. The Medical Review Board's judgment in these matters is critical to an effective transportation safety program. Screening and managing important medical conditions, like obstructive sleep disorder, improves truckers' health.

This medical question has been thoroughly studied and transparently debated. FMCSA began studying this question in 2004. On two occasions the Medical Review Board has considered the question of truckers and sleep disordered breathing (obstructive sleep apnea) and on both occasions that body has made recommendations to screen high risk truckers for obstructive sleep apnea. It has included several rounds of commissioned research and public hearings.

While not everyone likes the outcome, all sides have been heard. This Bill sets a bad precedent for politicizing medical decisions and will further delay implementation of a needed health care screening. It neither advances public safety nor improves the health of the trucker. I urge you to reject S. 1537.
