

2013 Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Service Award

The Martin Luther King Jr. Community Service Award is an award, which acknowledges outstanding student achievement in community service. Recipients of this award exemplify the principles, standards, and ideology of Martin Luther King, Jr.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

REQUIREMENTS:

Submit a completed application including a personal statement, two (2) references that can attest to your community involvement, and a current unofficial university transcript. The personal statement must be a maximum of two pages in length and it must describe your eligibility for the award and why community service is important to you.

The Martin Luther King, Jr. Planning Committee composed of faculty and staff of all four campuses will make the final selection procedure. However, faculty and staff will vote only for students of their own university. One award from each university (for a total of 4) will be presented. The recipients will receive a personal plaque to commemorate the occasion and their name will be inscribed on a plaque that is displayed in a designated area on each of the campuses to acknowledge the recipients. Recipients should be prepared to share a mini reflection about what Martin Luther King Jr.'s Dream means to you.

CRITERIA:

- To be eligible for this award, students must meet the following criteria:
- Be a full-time student at Dillard, Loyola, Tulane, or Xavier University
- In good academic standing: Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Have a good moral character displaying attributes such as honesty, fairness, conscientiousness, compassion and diplomatic skills.
- Have a strong community service background.
- Must perform a consistent record of community service during their university career.
- Dedicated to the improvement of the community.
