

Spring Creek Trail Underpass CLOSED through late fall 2013

Please note that the Trail near College Avenue will remain closed through late fall 2013, to ensure the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists in the area.

Please follow posted detour routes.

Although construction on the extension of the underpass is largely complete, several factors have forced the closure to remain in effect:

- The devastating floods that hit the Front Range last month occurred while construction was underway, causing significant delays until the area dried out and resources were recovered. Please be aware that wet weather may further affect construction timing.
- As the construction of a significant retaining wall for the MAX guideway continues, dangerous construction machinery is moving closer to the Spring Creek Trail. The underpass will not reopen until construction of the wall is complete and equipment is safely removed from the area.
- Since the area is an active construction site, it is an unsafe environment for untrained individuals not wearing standard Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
