She sells roasted peanuts to pay for household and educational expenses. She has told us about her past, and she is struggling to make sure that her children do not suffer the way that she is suffering.

I qualified for a ADIVIMA scholarship because my grandfather, Pedro Cortez López, was assassinated by the Guatemalan army on the 28th of September, 1982. It seems that because of this trauma my father has not been able to succeed in life. However, we children along with our mother are struggling and working to keep going.

Our biggest problem is economic. In these times we must buy corn. What we actually harvest ourselves does not suffice for a whole year. During the past few growing seasons we have been suffering from drought. The rain stops when the corn is ripening and we lose the crop.
