Generations Against Bullying is a non-profit organization serving communities, schools, teachers, coaches administrators, parents, law enforcement and bullied individuals.

We formed in 2012 after bomb threats in a local high school were attributed to students fed up with being bullied and wanting to get even.

Our goal is to provide the resources to help communities stop bullying and improve the lives, of both victims as well as their perpetrators, by restoring self-esteem and self worth, in schools across the country.

We organized to deal with the consequences of bullying from past generations that have created learned behaviors and patterns of abuse that are being carried on by the current generation of students. By helping to right the wrongs of yesterday and today, we hope to change the culture of learning for future generations.

85% of bullying will stop in the first 10 seconds if the bystander stands up.


Almost 7% of all high school students have attempted suicide as a way to escape being bullied.




Verbal or physical.
