About the presenter:

R. Walden Moore has been Director of Music of Trinity Church on the Green in New Haven, since 1984, where he works with the Choir of Men and Boys, the Choir of Men and Girls, and the Parish Choir (mixed adult choir) in a regular schedule of parish services and appearances outside the walls of the church. He has served as clinician, guest conductor and organist for choir festivals across the nation, most recently at the Royal School of Church Music in America's King's College Course in Wilkes-Barre, PA in 2012, and for the Charlotte Course in 2013. He is past Chair of the Music Commission of the Episcopal Diocese of Connecticut, and has served on the Executive Board of the Connecticut Chapter of the American Choral Directors Association. In

2007 he was appointed to the faculty of the Yale Institute of Sacred Music/School of Music as Lecturer (adj.) in Organ, where he teaches a yearly course in Liturgical Keyboard Skills.
