Conservation Development

Projects or programs that:

- Preserve or restore historic and cultural resources
- Support the viability of agricultural lands
- · Provide habitat corridors by linking open space networks
- Enhance natural areas provided by contiguous environmental lands
- Reduce wildfire damage
- Protect the night sky from unnecessary light
- · Create open spaces and/or recreational areas
- Reduces costs through efficient use of land, streets or utilities.

Healthy Community Design

Projects or programs that:

- · Create opportunities for people to be physically active and engage socially
- Create community gathering spaces
- Integrate open spaces or create parks
- · Offer pedestrian and bicycle access to land uses
- · Create connections to existing bicycle/pedestrian systems and Polk's trail network
- Support community gardens or offer access to fresh fruits and vegetables.

Sustainable Development

Projects or programs that:

• Reduce potable water use

- Reduce energy use and/or promote alternative energy sources
- Utilize recyclable materials
- Promote aging in place through universal design
- · Provide mix of land uses close in proximity
- Develop infill properties or redevelop existing sites
- Implement "Complete Streets" design principles to better serve all users
- Manage stormwater effectively
- · Reduce impact of built areas on natural movement of water
- Restore hydrologic and ecological functions of watersheds
- Promote economically efficient provision of infrastructure
