### FINANCIAL AID FOR HORSE RELATED ACTIVITIES

**The Peppermint Ponies 4-H club offers financial aid to current year enrolled club members to support individual pursuit of 4-H Horse project activities.** Four financial aid funds will be offered per year up to \$250 each. Member may apply for aid annually. Member may apply for additional aid as needed. Aid is used to pursue any horse related activities including, but not limited to:

#### **Uses of Financial Aid:**

- Summer camp at North Road Farm or elsewhere
- Horseback riding lessons at North Road Farm or elsewhere
- Club dues
- Horse show/event
- Field Trip
- Academic/tuition
- Learning materials books

#### **The Ideal Applicant:**

- Member of Peppermint Ponies 4-H Club for 1 year or longer
- Active in Horse Apprentice Program (HAP), or similar community service activity.
- Regularly attends 4H Club meetings and activities
- Has chosen horseback riding as a primary focus
- Has adult support for horse activities and transportation
- Participant in 4-H County Horse Show, Stratham or Deerfield Fairs
- Participate in 4-H Peppermint Ponies club fund-raising events

#### **Application Process**

Financial Aid application is on an open rolling basis. For priority consideration apply by February 1. For aid to attend 4-H County/State and/or Circuit Horse Shows apply by March 15. Applications after March 15 will be considered on an as needed basis. To apply, prepare answers to the following questions on the attached sheet or separate piece of paper:

3. Why are you interested in this particular horse activity?

#### **Parent/Guardian Questions:**
