

This year, Napa Valley CanDo volunteers return this new way of giving to the Valley. In communities already known for their generosity, the Give!Guide eases the path from your good intentions to action.

Here are 15 reasons why the 2014 Give! Guide makes so much sense.

- You can give to any of 40 fabulous nonprofits serving Napa County.
- 2. You can donate to one or more organizations in varying amounts beginning at \$10.
- 3. A compressed time-frame—November 1 December 31—encourages year-end giving and supports all those good-hearted procrastinators out there.
- 4. It provides multiple ways to donate: Give using the print catalog, our website in English and Spanish (NVGiveGuide.org) or via your smart phone.
- **5.** If you choose, honor someone with your gift by providing their name.
- It's easy: One-click completes all your taxdeductible transactions with one charge to your credit card.
- Tax-deductible receipts will be sent to you by each nonprofit to whom you've donated.
- 8. The website's real-time ticker shows donations hour by hour.
- **9.** There are terrific daily incentives for donors. See website for details.
- 10. It provides a creative opportunity for adults and children to give together.
- 11. Organizations, like scouting and schools, can use the Give!Guide to learn about local charitable efforts.
- 12. With the exception of usual credit card costs, all funds go to your selected nonprofits. CanDo takes no fee.
- 13. The CanDo Spirit Award, sponsored by the Napa Valley Vintners, recognizes with a \$1000 prize the dedication and hard work of one committed, young nonprofit employee.



- A festive kick-off celebration (November 6), free and open to the public, sets the tone. See website for details.
- 15. Finally, the Give!Guide fosters powerful, positive impacts: It raises funds and awareness for small to large local groups doing great work every day. It encourages collaboration among non-profit organizations. It helps cultivate a culture of giving for young and old, businesses and the nonprofit sector, first time givers and veteran philanthropists.

This year, many of the nonprofits featured in the Napa Valley Give!Guide found themselves displaced by the earthquake. Those they serve were faced with increased challenges. We've all reached out and helped in so many ways. Let the Give!Guide help continue those efforts.
