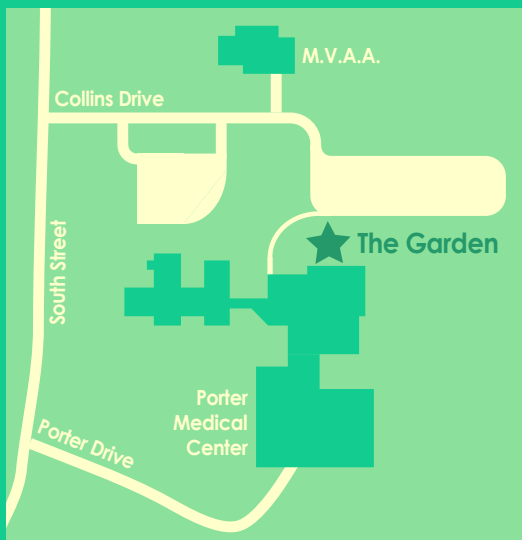
Middlebury Community Garden



The Middlebury Community Garden grew out of a group of people who loved gardening and community and wanted to bring the two closer together. Inspired by many community gardens throughout Vermont, we aim to provide a space for folks and families to learn how to grow food in a supportive and collaborative environment.

Located on the grounds of Porter Hospital, the garden provides sixteen plots to rent for the season. We offer 4' x 24' plots for \$30, fully tilled and amended with compost, plus water, tools, and advice from master gardeners.

Whether you preserve heirloom tomatoes or have never planted a seed, join us in this effort to bring Addison County residents together in celebration of healthy food.
