## **Please turn off your sprinklers!**

Recent storms provided all the water your landscapes need for at least another week or two without additional rainfall. While reservoir levels are up a bit, they are nowhere near normal levels and it is critical that conservation efforts continue.

If dry conditions persist in coming weeks, you may water up to two days per week as needed. Please remember that during this time of year your landscape needs very little water, so water only when absolutely necessary. Conservation experts say once every two or three weeks is plenty.

- Customers with even street numbers water on Wednesday and Sunday; those with odd street numbers water on Tuesday and Saturday. No watering allowed on Monday, Thursday and Friday.
- Please avoid excessive watering that runs off onto sidewalks, streets and gutters.
- Washing of streets, parking lots, driveways, sidewalks or buildings is prohibited except as necessary for health, sanitation or fire protection.
