2. Prepare one delicious dish in a quantity large enough to provide sample-sized portions to 400-500 people. (Enough food that would normally serve 100 can be cut into 4ths for sample-sizes.) We are not sure how many people will attend. Not every person will try every dish. Some chefs will run out of food and others will have leftovers.
3. If your food needs to be kept warm, please bring a chafing dish with sterno or request electricity and bring an extension cord. If your food needs to be kept cold, bring a cooler.
NO COOKING ON THE PROPERTY.
4. Bring any necessary serving pots, bowls, platters, serving utensils.
5. Consider decorating your table and dressing in costume. This is optional but will make the event a lot of fun! Trophies will be presented for the Best Decorated Table and the Bob Nicholas award for best Food.



The Coliseum & CrimeStoppers will:

1. Provide an 8' table for each team. Chairs, if requested,
2. Provide small plates, portion cups, forks, spoons, and napkins. We will also provide disposable gloves to team members.
