Silent Auction Chair - Barb and Darren Horvath

- Serve as members of the ShamRockin' for a Cure Board
- Manage and motivate committee members to secure items for silent auction (goal is 150 items or more)
- Coordinate Auction Battalion meetings and send recap notes of action items
- Ensure all paperwork is properly completed and give updates to the committee on a monthly basis
- Monitor solicited and received items to achieve a variety of items and price ranges
- Assist with the collection and storing of items received from volunteers and committee members
- Conduct monthly meetings with the CF Foundation to package items
- Work in collaboration with the CF Foundation on tracking of items, preparation of bid sheets, and descriptions
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, coordinate post event distribution systems (suggested 3 days for pick up at a certain location, then items go to CF Foundation for delivery)
- Oversee on-site setup and cleanup
- Train volunteer group on auction needs for night of bidding and checkout

Food & Beverage Chairs - Lara Dolan (Lead Chair)/ Phil Mello, Beth Culloty, and Erica Pomerance (Co-Chairs)

- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, create in-kind sponsorship offering for all food and beverage vendors
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, develop guidelines for each food and beverage vendor
- Secure, solicit, and coordinate food vendors to donate a minimum of 600 servings each (goal is to have 20 restaurants participate in 2015)
- Secure and coordinate beer, wine and liquor donations
- Coordinate menu items among food vendors
- Secure certificate of insurance from each participating vendor naming host venue as additionally insured
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, coordinate daily liquor license
- Oversee day of set up for food vendors and bars
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, schedule post follow-up meeting with all food and beverage vendors to secure recommitment

Live Auction/Bid for a Cure Chairs - Jon Baker (Lead Chair)/Jess Baker (Co-Chair)

- Lead chair serves as a member of the ShamRockin' for a Cure Board
- Identify, solicit, and secure live auction items (with fair market value of at least \$5,000 or more)
- Manage and motivate committee members to secure live auction items
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, responsible for creating promotional e-blasts to create a buzz for items
- In collaboration with CF Foundation work on flow of live auction and Bid for a Cure during the program
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, develop live auction booklet and day of presentation
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, assist with the securing of auctioneer
- Identify signage needs for live auction and Bid for a Cure (CF Foundation to print)

Corporate Sponsorship Chairs - Brian O'Reilly (Lead Chair)/John Carew (Co-Chair)

- Lead chair serves as a member of the ShamRockin' for a Cure Board
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, create two sponsorship cultivation events throughout the year that are donated in-kind
- Collaborate with CF Foundation and ShamRockin for a Cure Board to create sponsorship levels
- Monitor the number of sponsors in each business segment
- Coordinate Sponsorship Battalion meetings and send recap notes of action items
- Recommit and increase existing sponsor commitments
- Identify, solicit, and secure new corporate sponsors for ShamRockin' for a Cure
- Motivate and manage committee members to solicit and secure Corporate Sponsors
- Work with committee members to follow up and close corporate sponsors
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation and committee, secure guest names for corporate sponsors to provide physical tickets for the event
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, ensure corporate sponsors are properly represented
- Coordinate collection of swag bag items from sponsors and facilitate the preparation of goodie bags

Momentum Chairs - Tom Murphy (Lead Chair)/Jimmy Pomerance (Co-Chair)

- Identify in-kind restaurant partners to host at least four Momentum Meetings from October February (free food, cash bar)
- Coordinate with the CF Foundation to send event emails to committee and "friends" of ShamRockin' for a Cure"
- In collaboration with the CF Foundation, create agenda (run-of-show) for Momentum events 1 mission moment is needed at each event
- Send follow-up thank you notes from ShamRockin' for a Cure to all restaurant partners
- Motivate committee to sell tickets to ShamRockin' for a Cure

Set-Up Coordinator Chair - Suzanne Starr

- Work with Event, Sponsorship and Auction Chair(s) to identify needs for set up
- Secure committee participation for ShamRockin' for a Cure set up and breakdown (Friday, Saturday, Monday)
- Create "Sign Up Genius" that shows all set-up needs for Friday, Saturday and Monday
- Track, communicate with, and assign committee to set-up needs if they have not signed up for a task
- Serve as Chief Motivator for help on these important logistics needs at all committee meetings
