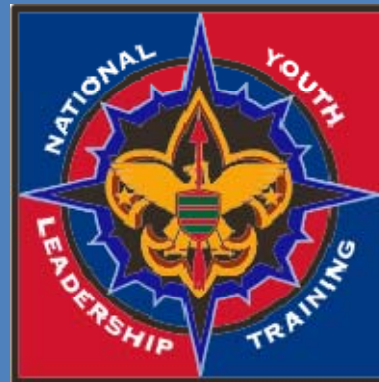

## What to Expect at NYLT

## What to Bring to Camp

After your registration is accepted, you will receive a welcome email with a list of what to bring to NYLT. In general, a participant will bring camping gear for each weekend. Food is provided. Be sure to indicate shirt size on the application form to ensure proper fit of the provided course shirt.

## Who May Attend

Requirements are:

- Venturers are eligible to attend NYLT, must be 13 and have completed Intro to Leadership Skills for Crews.
- A Scout must have attained the rank of First Class and must be 13 years old (or have completed 7<sup>th</sup> grade) by the start of the course and completed Intro to Leadership Skills for Troops.
- Sea Scouts are eligible to attend NYLT, must be 13 and have completed Intro to Leadership Skills for Ships.
- He/she must be (or plan to be) a troop officer, crew, ship, or team leader.

## Uniform

A complete official field uniform, as applies to your unit, is required. Weather permitting, Activity Uniforms may be worn at appropriate times. A NYLT course shirt will be provided.
