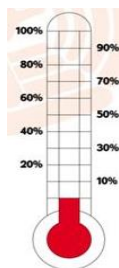


Troop Committee Challenge and Merit Badge Counselor Orientation

TCC is for Troop Committee member's introduction to the Boy Scouts of America and to the responsibilities, opportunities, and resources that will ensure a successful troop leadership experience. Course topics include: The Organization of Scouting, Role of the Troop Committee, How to Run a Committee Meeting, Roles and Responsibilities by Position, Advancement, Program Planning, Membership and Delivering the Scouting Promise. **Required for ALL CVC Troop Committee Members by EOY 2014.**

MBC Training guides merit badge counselors through their responsibilities in the role and will give them an understanding of the methods of counseling Scouts. It is intended as a short orientation course for all merit badge counselors before they begin working with Scouts. At the end of this lesson, participants will be able to: Understand the aims of Scouting, the BSA advancement process, and the MBC's role; Know a merit badge counselor's duties and responsibilities to the BSA and the Scout; Understand & complete the requirements to be a registered merit badge counselor; List some methods of counseling and coaching; and Successfully guide a Scout through the merit badge process.
