
National Youth Leadership Training Course 2014



Participant Application Package

Who Should Attend? All registered Scouts or Venturers (age 13 and older by June 1, 2014) who would like to improve their leadership skills.

What is National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)? NYLT is an intense weeklong youth-oriented leadership training experience sponsored by the Colonial Virginia Council. The course is held at the Bayport Scout Reservation near Jamaica, Virginia. Highly qualified youth staff, under the supervision of adult advisors, will conduct the training using the National Youth Leadership Training Course syllabus, as published by the National Council, Boy Scouts of America.

WHAT IS NYLT? NYLT is an exciting week-long training opportunity for youth leaders in BSA units. The course models a month in the life of a Scout Unit – three meetings (one each day for the first three days) leading up to a big outdoor experience (an overnight outpost camp). The course uses the Patrol method and presents model Patrol Leader Council meetings. Patrols are challenged early in the week to present to the unit at the end of the week their "Quest for the Meaning of Leadership." While the challenge is designed to have them go through the four stages of team development, it will help patrols and individual Scouts/Venturers internalize the leadership skills and concepts being presented to them along the way. Throughout the course, the staff will model the concepts and skills that are the core content of the course. The focus of each session is not only knowledge but also giving Scouts a "Toolbox of Skills" that equips them with the "how" of leadership.

<u>WHAT NYLT IS NOT!</u> It is not a week of summer camp, it is not free time, it is not an opportunity to earn merit badges, and it is definitely not a vacation.

ELIGIBILITY. Requirements are:

- Venturers are eligible to attend NYLT, must be 13 and have completed ILSC.
- A Scout must have attained the rank of First Class and must be at least 13 years old (or have completed 7th grade) by the start of the course and completed ILST.
- He/She must be (or plan to be) a troop officer,
 Crew or Team leader.

ACTIVITIES. The course uses basic Scouting skills to teach and practice teamwork. During the week, the Patrol members will participate in cooking, knot tying, lashing, hiking, orienteering, geo-caching, team building games, campfire programs, services of reverence, flag ceremonies, planning meetings, and classroom learning.

APPLICATION AND MEDICAL FORMS. Please complete all the spaces and sign at all the appropriate places on each of the forms. The medical form is required for a Scout to be in camp. Any Scout that does not have all completed forms will be asked to return home. It is recommended that you keep a copy of all forms and bring them to registration in case verification is necessary.

COURSE FEE - \$225. The fee includes all meals, two NYLT t-shirts, and all program supplies. Fee payment schedule: a deposit of \$75 is due with submission of the application. The remaining \$150 fee is due no later than June 2, 2014. Transportation to and from Bayport is not included. Partial Camper Scholarships may also be available – apply through Course Director. The Unit may choose to pay part of this fee. If a Scout cancels prior to May 17th, a \$40 processing fee will be withheld from the refund. After May 17th, the course fees are completely non-refundable, but may be transferred to another Scout attending NYLT, if spaces are available. "Replacement" Scouts will be placed on the Waiting List if the week is full and will be offered openings on

a first-come, first-served basis.

<u>UNIFORM</u>. A complete official uniform (Field Uniform), consisting of Scout shorts or pants, Scout socks, Scout belt, and a Scout shirt (with properly placed insignia – including World Crest, current rank, Council shoulder patch, Unit number, and Green epaulets are required. <u>The Field Uniform must be worn for the Scout/Venturer to check in</u>. During appropriate times during the course, Activity Uniforms, consisting of Scout shorts or pants, Scout socks, Scout belt, and a provided NYLT course t-shirt will be worn. Since the Activity or Field Uniforms will be worn at all times during the course, additional socks, shorts and/or Scout pants are desirable.

THIS APPLICATION SHOULD BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN May 17,

2014. Applications are accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis (qualifications taken into consideration) and all applicants are not automatically accepted. **No more than three (3) participants per troop are eligible to attend the course**. Applications received after the course is full will be placed on a waiting list.

Each applicant will receive a confirmation packet from the Course Registrar. The packet will include:

- 1. A complete list of personal equipment required
- 2. A map to Bayport Scout Reservation
