Rule 16 - *Utilization Standards* and Rule 18 - *Medical Fee Schedule* Changes Effective January 1, 2015

 - Psychiatric/Psychological and Biofeedback updates and changes
 - Clarified IV infusion billing and fees for different sites of service
 - Moved Dry Needling from modalities under PM&R to a procedure and aligned fees with Acupuncture fees
 - New Tele-Health fee schedule
 - Supplies/DME/Orthotics and Prostheses and Vaccine/Toxoid fee changes
 - Clarifying and updating fees for ASCs and hospitals (inpatient and outpatient) and freestanding diagnostic testing facilities
 - Home Care Services fees clarified and updated
 - Medication and Rx drug billing and fee clarifications
- 4. Opportunity for the public to exchange information between each other and with Division representatives.
