1 Hour Classes: (All Ages)

\$50.00 per month for 1 class/week \$80 per month for 2 classes/week \$100 per month for 3 classes/week \$22 for each additional class/week. Note: 1½ hours of class = \$70/month.

Unlimited classes: Take as many classes as you wish for \$157/month.

Private Classes:

Let one of our master teachers choreograph your solo, help get you ready for an audition or pageant, or work on your technique. Call the studio or speak with your teacher to work out the details.

Late Fee Policy: There is a \$10 fee for tuition paid after the 10th of the month.

Costume Fees (Spring Revue):
