So that's why we donate to organizations like HCWC. The message is love. We give a certain percent of our income every quarter to our missions and benevolence. Our committee decides who and where we donate.

How many other areas do you give to?

There's about 10 organizations that we give to each quarter. We like to evaluate all of them every once in a while. We feel it's our fiduciary responsibility to make sure that our money is doing some good.

What is special about belonging to your congregation in Wimberley?

Every time we have a service, we end it by singing "Blessed be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian
