Important Information for July 29 Rally Participants

When you arrive in Denver - Restrooms and Parking:

Upon arriving in Denver, you may swing by the Independence Institute at 727 East 16th Street to use restrooms and pick up bottled water. The Capitol is within walking distance (approximately 6 blocks). Cars may park at the Independence Institute (they have space for about 30 cars. There are surface parking lots within the two-block area around the Capitol. There is also Metered street parking in the area but limited to 2 hour parking.

Buses may park adjacent to Capitol in spaces marked with yellow hooded meters. Buses will need to display their permit on the dashboard while parked. OUR rally area is down the hill in the park between Lincoln and Broadway. There is a pro-regulation rally on the West steps of the Capitol and others near EPA. Anti-coal organizations have made a big push to support the regulations and are out in force. **Use common sense – do not attempt to confront or argue with them. They are looking for opportunities to film us or portray us unfavorably**. We don't want any altercations (Capitol is staffed with State Patrol).

Restrooms while at Rally:

There are restrooms in the Capitol. Enter through the visitor's entrance on south side (14th avenue) of building. Go thru Security check and straight through coffee shop area thru double doors. Ladies on the left side of double doors, men on the right side.

There are also Porta-Potties on the Civic Center grounds across Broadway where the food trucks are gathered.

Food Options:

For those needing to purchase lunch after arriving in Denver, there are several options including the following:

On Tuesdays there are food vendors at Civic Center Park across Broadway from 11-2.

Panera (sandwiches, salads, cookies) 1360 Grant just south of Capitol Tokyo Joes (Japanese noodle bowls and salads) 1350 Grant just south of Capitol Quiznos (one block south of Capitol at 13th and Grant) Jimmy John's submarines (corner of 16th and Broadway)

There is also a small coffee shop in the Capitol where you can get a sandwich or pre-made burrito and a larger one across the street from Capitol at 1525 Sherman.
