Program Goal:

The Literature Evangelist Program in the Southern New England Conference will share the good news of Jesus through the printed page. The goal is to have a team of Literature Evangelists working in cooperation with our pastors, churches, and SNEC sponsored events. This cooperative approach is to increase the effectiveness of the contacts made by the individual Literature Evangelists.

Position Description:

The Literature Evangelism Program Leader will establish the SNEC Literature Evangelist Program by recruiting, training, and managing a group of independently contracted Literature Evangelists.

Responsibilities:

Develop and update as necessary an SNEC Literature Evangelist Job Description

Recruit and train Literature Evangelists to work among (but not exclusive to) the major SNEC language groups.

Literature Evangelist training should be in the field and classroom, with individuals and groups.

Develop and implement a strategy to advertise Literature Evangelist services and products to the public.

Liaison between Literature Evangelist's, pastors, and churches.

Support SNEC evangelism events by deploying Literature Evangelists to areas where SNEC sponsored events will be held.

Keep SNEC Administration informed about the progress of the Literature Evangelists with a monthly statistical report of defined areas of assessment. (Areas of assessment will be chosen from the as yet to be developed Literature Evangelist Job Description)

Must be an active church member in regular standing.

Worship in SNEC Churches and promote the Literature Evangelist program.

The Program Leader is encouraged to be an active Literature Evangelist outside the hours of this job.

Plan, recruit, and manage a summer-time Student Literature Evangelist Program.
