Seraphine. Made in 2008, it was based on the true story of a French artist who lived in the first half of the 20th century. A poor servant, she secretly painted obsessively using mainly materials



found around her - wax from the church candles, plant matter etc. The story of her discovery of course was not a straightforward one, but her work can now be seen in major civic galleries in France. It was a beautiful film, subtle and mesmerising, and appreciated by our audience.

New Constitution

As Secretary of the Bath-Aix Twinning Association I have been working with the secretaries of the other Associations to produce a common form of constitution, which will be agreed at our November meeting.
