DVA Clinic Policies

Registration/Payment

- Our Clinic Programs have limited space. Please apply early.
- Applicants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration and full payment is required to guarantee placement in camp/clinic.
- Full clinic registration fees apply to every participant.
- No prorates for clinics.
- Online registration through our registration module is REQUIRED and includes completion of a Medical and Liability Waiver.
- An automatic confirmation is sent for each clinic registration.

Arrival & Check-In

- Please arrive **no less than 15 minutes** prior to clinic for check-in.
- All participants must sign in each week at clinic.
- A parent or guardian must be present at all times for clinics for K-8th grade
- Parental assistance may be needed for bathroom emergencies, etc.
- Parents please pick your athlete up on time.

Equipment

It is recommend to bring and wear the following:

- Running Shoes
- Comfortable T-shirt
- Knee Pads
- Water Bottle

^{*}Players will not be permitted to practice if players do not have proper foot attire and/or knee pads.

Cancellation Policy

DVA reserve the right to cancel any clinic which does not achieve established minimum registration requirements. You will be notified by e-mail should a cancellation be necessary. A full-refund will be given if DVA has to cancel a clinic program.

No Shows/Withdrawals/Refunds

- DVA does not provide refunds for No Shows or withdrawal from its clinic sessions, unless under special circumstances. This is at the discretion of DVA.
- If a clinic session is canceled due to weather, DVA will make every effort to try and make up the missed clinic session. If a clinic session cannot be made up a credit will be give to a future clinic for up to 1 year from the date of cancelation. If only a single day is missed, then only a credit of a single day clinic will be made up.
