FACING THE FACTS

+ Nearly **one in five Kindergarten** students in Nevada have no form of health insurance.*

+ Nevada is ranked as the **48th worst state for lack of health coverage** for children.*

+ **The Children's Free Clinic of Southern Nevada is the first completely free clinic** for children in the state of Nevada.

+ 88% of our patients live at or **below the Federal Poverty Line.**

+ The typical family we serve is comprised of two parents with either two or three children.

The average annual household income for these families is \$13,105 or \$1,092 a month.

+ The Children's Free Clinic of Southern Nevada and our partners provide free prescription medications, free vision and eye disease screening, and asthma care.

And the good news doesn't stop there. We also serve as a training location for student health professionals from a variety of Nevada institutions, so they can learn in a real-world setting.

DR. NOAH KOHN might as well have a doctorate in doing good. As the Medical Director of The Children's Free Clinic of Southern Nevada, he has devoted himself entirely to helping children. After working in private pediatric practice for several years, he decided he needed to do more. There were countless children out there that had no one to turn to. If they got sick, their entire future could be unraveled. Knowing this, Dr. Kohn closed his practice, laced up his doctoring boots, and founded The Children's Free Clinic of Southern Nevada.



Since then, he has helped thousands of underprivileged children in our community, and he even travelled to Haiti after the devastating earthquake to assist in medical relief. In honor of all that he has done, Dr. Kohn has been recognized by the United Way of Southern Nevada and Channel 8 KLAS with a "Community Spirit Award," a "Healthcare Headliners Award" from In Business Las Vegas, and he was even named one of seven worldwide nominees for 2010's "Passion Award" by the Swiss watchmaker Frederique Constant.

The National Assembly of School-based Health Care has estimated that Nevada would need at least 57 pediatric clinics to be on par with the national average. **Our state currently has four.**
