

BERLIN WALL BIKE TRIP: PEACEMAKING FOR YOUNG ADULTS

Our German Partners in Berlin are inviting a group of eight young people (minimum age 17) and one adult advisor from Penn Central Conference to be their guests from July 10th through 21st for a Bike Trip along the so called Berlin Wall Trail (following the former Berlin Wall that divided the town until 1989).

The hosts will be the church districts of Spandau and Falkensee. The participants will depart the United States on July 9th and arrive in Berlin on July 10th. The schedule will begin with a long weekend with families including a few common activities in the area of Spandau, formerly a town of its own in the north west of Berlin now part of the metropolitan area.

On Monday the group will start the bike trip and end on Saturday. After the trip, participants will return to the hosting families for another weekend. The flight back to the US will be on July 21.

The invitation will cover all the costs for lodging, transportation inside Germany, food, and a basic cultural program to learn about Berlin's history and present. Not included is the flight and personal activities beyond the program.
