


Doukénie

WINERY
Purcellville, Virginia



Located near historic Leesburg in the town of Purcellville, Doukénie Winery is made up of 415 acres nestled in Loudoun County, Virginia's famed "wine country," just 50 miles from Washington, DC. This wine farm provides visitors and locals an escape from reality while increasing their knowledge of wine and wine making.

Founded in 1985 by the Bazaco family, Doukénie Winery produced its first vintage in 1995 and within the last several years has received numerous prestigious awards. The winery produces four to five thousand cases per year consisting of five white wines, one dessert wine and nine red wines. All can be purchased through their Heritage Club or at the winery.



There are many things that make Doukénie Winery unique? First is a visit to the winery tasting room where visitors learn as they taste. Each tasting includes six wines (2 white, 3 reds, and one dessert wine). The staff of wine educators are trained with input from Sébastien Marquet, the winemaker and general manager. During each training session, they learn about vine management, distinct differences in each varietal and what to look for when tasting. They share their knowledge with visitors.

Be sure to register for the Doukénie Winery Sweepstakes: Blending with the Winemaker on March 22, 2014. Learn the secrets of making an excellent blend with our winemaker, Sebastien Marquet. Class is conducted in the barrel room where exact measurements of certain varietals can make all the difference. Guided and instructed by a master, help Doukénie create our next Vintner's reserve. Good for 4 people, valued at \$40/person (total \$160) Class begins at 1 pm and ends at 4 pm.



Doukénie Winery is a wonderful venue for private events, particularly weddings. According to comments by brides and event planners, Doukénie is "DC's place for weddings and events and Maria is top notch to work with." [Wedding Wire](#) has many reviews.

Special events are held at the winery throughout the year. Starting in April, and back by popular demand, are Bistro Nights. Every
