After returning from HOBY, Sarah examined her community's needs and founded iConquer—a program dedicated to educating three to six year olds about obesity through puppet shows, self-produced videos, arts and crafts, and exercise-dance routines.

She also helped found Project KNIGHTS, or Keep Nurturing and Inspiring Good Habits in Teen Sleep, in order to educate teenagers about the hazards of sleep deprivation. Through various partnerships, these organizations have reached over 20,000 students and raised more than \$70,000 to help educate students of all ages about healthy living.
