Have you ever longed for more from your life? Do you watch others fearlessly follow their dreams and wonder "How can I do that, too?" Do you feel lost? Discovery 1 What is my call?

No one is an island. God has promised us "Be not afraid, for I am with you" (Isaiah 41:10). Throughout The Journey, you will be surrounded by others who can support you throughout your personal journey to discover God's call and mission for your life.
